Our first day for Glenbrook students on campus to begin their academic 20-21 school year has not changed. It is Friday, August 7, 2020. Students in grades 7 – 12 will report at 7:50 AM for an abbreviated school day. K – 6 grade students will come at the specified time. Schedules and procedures will be included with your registration packet.

Our new teachers will attend in-service training beginning August 4th, with returning staff joining them for additional in-service training on August 5th and 6th.

We will have enhanced health and safety measures in place for those who come to our campus. The Glenbrook protocol is being developed based on both federal and state guidelines.

In Governor John Bel Edwards' press conference yesterday, he stated that it is our goal to reopen schools. He then followed with "it is impossible to know on July 8th what it is going to look like" (in August). Therefore, Glenbrook continues to have as our goal to prepare our students, while keeping them safe.
