

2024-2025 Re-Registration and Registration Instructions

"Re-registration" of currently enrolled students and "New Student" registration for siblings of currently enrolled Glenbrook students begins February 22, 2024. Glenbrook Alumni or Minden Montessori of Glenbrook School parents who have a student entering Kindergarten may register that child for Kindergarten on this day.

The Application for enrollment for new students is attached and re-registration information will be mailed to each Glenbrook family on February 16th. We encourage you to re-register your child/children no later than <u>February 29th</u> to secure their spots for the 2024/25 school year. You may mail in your re-registration and registration, send it to the school with your child, or bring it to Glenbrook School. Alumni and Minden Montessori of Glenbrook School families may bring their Kindergarten registration to the school beginning at 7:00 A.M. on February 22, 2024.

"New Student" Registration will <u>open to the public</u> on <u>March 07, 2024</u>. You may bring your registration paperwork and fee to the school beginning at 7:00 A.M. on that day. As several of our grades are at or near capacity, we encourage you to register on this date.

Our Counselor, Mrs. Scroggs, will contact families in the weeks following the open registration date to set up testing for your child.

Student Fees are required at the time the application is submitted

Registration & Testing Fee = \$300.00 per child

Re-Registration Fee = \$300.00 per child

TUITION: (NON-REFUNDABLE)

Payments are to be paid the 1st day of the month. Payments made after the 10th will be assessed a late fee of \$50.00. Tuition is set up in 12 monthly installments unless your child is a Senior, or you request the 10 month payment schedule. You may also choose to pay your tuition in advance for the year and receive a 5% discount. Enrollment of your child at Glenbrook School obligates you to pay the full tuition for the year, unless you move from the area, or your child is expelled from the school. A payment is not the cost of education for the month, but simply a division of the total tuition cost. An unpaid balance on your account after 60 days will result in the suspension of your child(ren) from the school, until full payment is received. Students will not be admitted for a new school year until all payments and other fees for the prior year are current.

Tuition Schedule 2024-2025

All registration and re-registration fees are \$300 per child. Returning students paying by re-registration deadline may pay ½ at that time and the remainder when school begins. Those students registering for the first time and any students re-registering after the deadline will pay the full \$300.

Tuition can be paid in full or on a 10-month or 12-month schedule. Tuition for senior students must be paid in full or on a 10-month schedule.

Discount Rules for Base Tuition Amounts:

- 1. Families with more than one child in Kindergarten through 8th grade will fall under the Table 1 discount scenario.
- 2. Families with multiple students in **Grades 9 12** will pay tuition as listed in Table 2.
- 3. Families with a student in **Kindergarten through 8th grade** and in **Grades 9 12**: The oldest child is the first child. The child/children in grades 9 -12 will pay tuition based on Table 2. Additional students in Kindergarten 8th grade will pay tuition based on Table 1.[For example: A Senior would cost \$5,365 and an 8th grader would receive a 50% second child discount of \$3,575. In the event that there was a third or fourth child in grades Kindergarten 8th he/she would receive a discount of \$5,350.]
