RE: Notification of asbestos inspection and Management Plan

To Whom It May Concern:

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986 required the nation's schools to conduct detailed inspections to identify all asbestos-containing materials that might be present in the school environment. AHERA required the inspection results and the associated management plan be submitted to the Governor. A copy of the AHERA Management Plan must be kept and maintained at the school administrative office for review by the public at no cost.

Glenbrook School maintains a proactive asbestos awareness program for the Glenbrook School. Periodic surveillances are performed twice yearly by a Competent Person. These surveillance reports are updated as needed and available for review in the AHERA Management Plan.
